2. TEACHING & LEARNING :

1. Physical Education Class : Many physical activities are done during this period. The studnets were taught how to maintain a good and healthy diet etc.



2. Reading and Reflection class : This is basically a Library period where a student is exposed to many different books, they cultivate discipline by maintaining silent and also develop the habit of reading books.



3. Activity Period : The activity classes is introduced for the students and the class teacher to have a strong bond. During this period the students are engaged with art and craft, learning basic etiquette and many more.



4. Cursive writing, English conversation and Dictation : As the school is situated in the outskirts, many students fails to have a basic English conversation and thus with the need of learning these classes were introduced.

5. Remedial Classes : The class 8 students in our school are going to be the first batch writing the matric exam. Grooming them by now can make them ready for 10th exam by two years. This initiative is taken from this year onwards by giving free tuitions to all the students of class 8 from 3 pm to 4:50 pm everyday. A routine is made for the teachers in the campus to guide the students.



2.6. First Day of School : The first day of school is the first day of an academic year. Oasis Academy started the New Academic 2023-24 from 12th April 2023. On the first day of school we had 56 students. The school prepares itself with the First day of school photo booth and red carpet. Welcome banners and welcome cards. 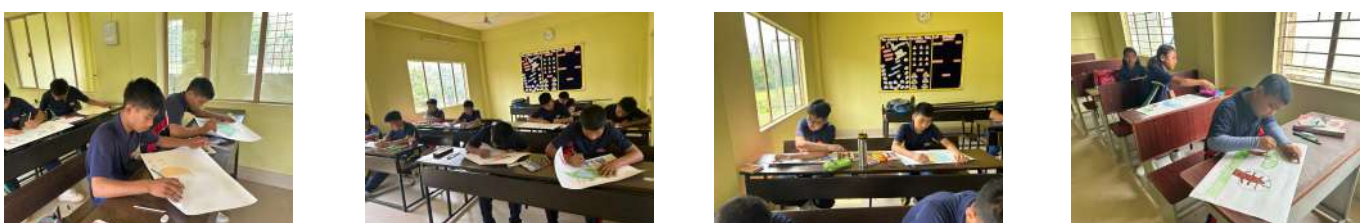
