2. TEACHING & LEARNING :

4. SCHOOL EVENTS/PROGRAMS/CELEBRATIONS:

4.1. Psychology Counselling for boarders : Oasis Academy, in collaboration with Huldah Buntain Theological College, conducted a Psychology Counseling program during the week of February 6 to 9, 2024. The program aimed to enhance the emotional well-being and interpersonal skills of participating students. With sessions scheduled from Monday to Thursday, as well as on weekends, students were provided ample opportunities to engage in counseling sessions outside of their regular academic commitments. Additionally, free medicines were distributed to attendees, further contributing to their overall health and providing essential support to underserved communities. The success of the eye screening camp highlights the dedication of Oasis Academy and its partners to addressing healthcare disparities and improving access to essential medical services for all members of the community.

5. GENERAL UPDATES/ACTIVITIES :

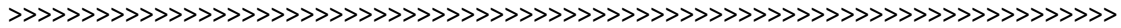
- 5.1. Students Transfer certificate filing dates was communicated to the parents on 3rd feb 2024.
