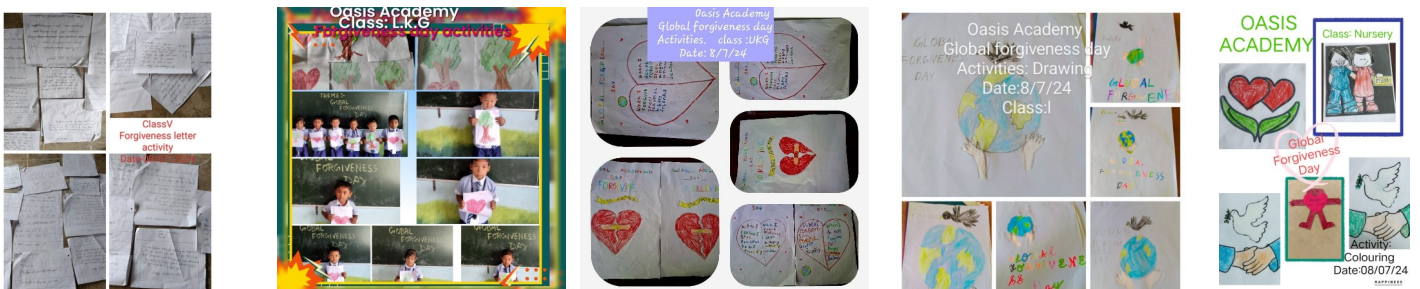
3.2. CLUB ACTIVITIES :

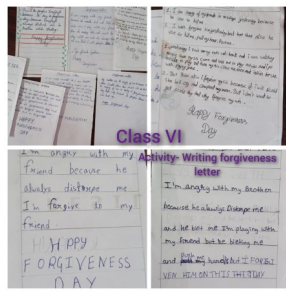
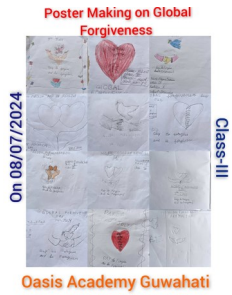
