3.2. SCIENCE LABORATORY & INFIRMARY SET UP:

On 18th May 2023, the infirmary and science laboratory were successfully set up. The infirmary has all medical emergencies and provide healthcare services to students. The science laboratory is outfitted with static model or human organs, charts and few experiment products, to enhance the learning experience and support practical science education. These new additions are significant improvements to the school infrastructure, contributing to better health and educational outcomes for our students.









3.3. CORRIDORS FRAME PROJECT:

The Frame Project commenced on 21st May 2024. The project's aim was to create a more learning-friendly school environment. To achieve this, each classroom floor was adorned with handmade frames featuring Indian and Assamese freedom fighters, Nobel Prize winners, and prominent social figures in various fields. These frames were crafted using recycled materials by students during their activity periods.
