# 2.2. PREPAREDNESS FOR SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT II:

The examination was scheduled from 24th February to 7th March 2025. The following steps were taken to ensure the smooth conduct of the exam:

- 2.3.0. Examination Orientation: An examination orientation was held in two phases:
- 20th February 2025: A session was conducted with teachers to brief them on their roles and responsibilities during the examination.
- 21st February 2025: Teachers conducted an orientation for students, providing details about the exam schedule, timings, and general examination protocols.
- **2.3.1. Examination Routine :** The examination routine for all classes, from Nursery to Class VIII, was prepared following the standard pattern and distributed to students on 5th February 2025.
  - **2.3.2. Examination Sitting Plan :** The seating arrangement was finalized on 19th February 2025, ensuring an organized setup that prevented students from the same class from sitting together, maintaining discipline and fairness.
  - **2.3.3.** Examination Register: A comprehensive examination register was maintained, recording subject-wise details, exam schedules, and student attendance, ensuring accurate monitoring throughout the assessment period.
  - **2.3.4.** Examination Admit Card: The admit cards were distributed on 7th February 2025, containing essential student details. These were mandatory for entry into the examination hall, facilitating smooth verification

and compliance with examination protocols.

- **2.3.5.** Examination Attendance Chart: A dedicated attendance chart was created to record student presence during each exam, separate from the regular attendance register, ensuring accurate tracking of participation.
- **2.3.6.** Examination Duty Chart: A duty chart was implemented to assign teachers to different examination halls on a rotation basis, ensuring equal distribution of responsibilities and adequate supervision.
- **2.3.7. Summative Assessment II :** Summative Assessment II was conducted from 24th February to 7th March 2025. The examination process proceeded smoothly, reflecting the effectiveness of the planning and organization.

skills to ensure accurate, structured, and visually appealing event documentation. Participants appreciated the training as a valuable step toward improving communication and record-keeping across Northeast India.
