2. ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

2.1. Habit Champion of the Month – May 2025 :

2.2 Periodic Test 1 – Academic Session 2025–26

As part of the academic evaluation process, Oasis Academy successfully conducted the Periodic Test 1 for the session 2025–26. The test aimed to assess students' academic progress and reinforce the importance of consistent learning.

1. **Admit Card Distribution:** Admit cards were issued to all students on 2nd June 2025, ensuring readiness and transparency in the examination process.

1. **Commencement of Examination:** The Periodic Test 1 was conducted from 9th June to 18th June 2025. It was the first formal assessment of the year, and all students appeared for the exams with sincerity and focus.

3. EVENTS & CELEBRATIONS

3.1. Report on the Observation of World Environment Day at Oasis Academy :

Oasis Academy observed World Environment Day with a deep sense of purpose and participation, blending awareness with action to instill environmental consciousness among students. The theme, "Beat Plastic Pollution," served as a guiding force throughout the day's activities, encouraging students to take responsibility for protecting the planet.

The observance unfolded in two meaningful phases:

Phase I: Morning Assembly – Spreading Awareness

Chik Association, Mairapur, Rani, students and staff planted Ashoka and Deva-da saplings both at the Mairapur Ground and within the school campus. The association generously donated the saplings and joined in the plantation drive, making it a true example of community partnership for a cause.



Indoor Activities: Students from Class V and below engaged in creative and educational indoor activities

such as slogan writing, drawing, colouring, and debates, all centered around the theme "Beat Plastic Pollution." These activities allowed younger students to explore environmental themes in age-appropriate and imaginative ways.

Additionally, the school actively took part in a Signature Campaign initiated by the Head of DRR, ER, CCA & NE, Oasis India. Through this campaign, students and staff pledged to reduce plastic usage and commit to sustainable practices, reinforcing the values of environmental stewardship.



Through this observance, Oasis Academy successfully encouraged hands-on learning, civic responsibility, and community collaboration, making World Environment Day not just an event, but a step toward lifelong environmental commitment.



3.2. International Yoga cum World Music Day Celebration :

3.3. Observation of the International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking :


5. STAFF TRAINING

5.1. Training on HRMS :

A comprehensive training session on the newly introduced HRMS (Human Resource Management System) software was conducted for all staff of Oasis India, with the Oasis Academy staff also actively participating. The session was held online via Zoom on 24th June 2025, with the aim of equipping participants with essential knowledge of both the mobile and web applications of the HRMS platform.



The training commenced with a welcome and session overview by Mr. Philip Devaraj, HR Manager – Learning and Development (Acting), who outlined the objectives and importance of the new system.
